The Morro Bay Junior Yacht Club (MBJYC) is sponsored by the Morro Bay Yacht Club (MBYC) to promote youth sailing and boating. ### Membership

Membership is open to anyone 8 or older and under the age of 21 with basic sailing experience. Fulfillment of a MBYC Summer Sailing course may meet the basic sailing experience requirement.

Dues are \$100 per year for the first child in a family, and \$60 for siblings. This money goes to assist with boat maintenance and fuel for the safety boats.
